

#### **Cooking Through the Calendar**

#### **September—Ramen Skillet Dinner**

#### Ingredients:

2 tsp. vegetable oil

1 medium onion, chopped

1 medium carrot, thinly sliced

1 bag (16 oz.) frozen broccoli

2 cups cooked chicken, chopped

1 pkg. (3 oz.) chicken flavored instant ramen Noodles

1 cup water

1/2 tsp. garlic powder

1/2 tsp. ground ginger

1/2 tsp. red pepper flakes

#### **Directions:**

- Wash hands with warm water and soap for at least 20 seconds.
- Wash fresh produce under cool running water, using a vegetable brush to scrub veggies with a firm surface. Dry and cut to prepare for this recipe.
- Heat oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add onion, carrot, and broccoli. Cook until vegetables are crisp tender (about 5 minutes).
- 4. Add the cooked chicken to the skillet. Stir and heat, about 1 to 2 minutes.
- In a small bowl, combine the contents of the ramen seasoning packet, water, garlic powder, ginger and red pepper flakes.
- 6. Pour the water and seasonings into the skillet. Stir and bring to a boil.
- Break ramen noodles apart and add to skillet. Stir to moisten noodles.
- 8. Cover the skillet and cook until noodles soften (about 2 minutes). Serve immediately.
- 9. Refrigerate leftovers within 2 hours.



## Gallatin County Funtime Quilters



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
